- Committed to the Society of Jesus
- Pursued education at the Universities of Coimbra and Évora in Portugal



Middle Knowledge	Truths which refer to what would be the case if various states of affairs were to obtain. Knowledge of counterfactuals. God's knowledge of what creatures would freely do in various sets of circumstances prior to His decree to create a world, which thus narrows down the possible worlds to the ones that are feasible for God to create based on creaturely free choices.	If person, P, were in situation, S, then P would freely perform action, A "If Caleb were to have the opportunity to teach on Molinism, then Caleb would freely prepare his lesson."
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The Three Moments of Molinism in terms of "Could," "Would," and "Will"

God uses His omniscience to perfectly accomplish His will.

1 st Moment: God's Natural Knowledge	"Could" Everything that could happen	God knows all possibilities			
2 nd Moment: God's Middle Knowledge	"Would" Everything that would happen	God knows which possibilities are feasible			
Between the 2 nd and 3 rd moment: God freely and sovereignly chooses this particular world from the infinite number of feasible possibilities					
3 rd Moment: God's Free Knowledge	"Will" Everything that will happen	God exhaustively knows all things
